- ❖ **We partnered with ICampus Liberia, the Irish Embassy Monrovia, and the British Embassy Monrovia to build the first inclusion cafe in Liberia.**
- ❖ **We established a year around paid fellowship program (work readiness) for young individuals in the Liberian disabled community.**
- ❖ **Through our partnership, we were able to build numerous prostheses, provide counseling services, physical therapy, school assistance, and much more to the young amputees we serve.**
- ❖ **We were able to provide bone trimming surgery to three young amputees, including a bilateral amputee.**
- ❖ **Our radio program audience increased as well as our radio team members.**
- ❖ **We established three new partners.**
- ❖ **We established two new school clubs at our partnered schools for the deaf.**
- ❖ **We added one new school for the deaf to our school club partners.**
- ❖ **Our school clubs impacted over 100 students at Liberian schools for the deaf.**
- ❖ **Through our partnership, we were able to renovate an orphanage home, and school for young people with profound hearing loss.**
